EdHeroes Hub supports the EdHeroes Network to accelerate the achievement of UN SDG4 (quality education) within the country where the organization operates.

EdHeroes Indonesia Hub is created in collaboration with Pijar Foundation

[Pijar Foundation](#) is the ecosystem of strategic players focused on guiding and assisting in preparing themselves to embrace future trends, opportunities, and challenges.

During the launch of EdHeroes Indonesian Hub, Pijar Foundation also announced the Global Future Talent Alliance initiative.

GFTA is a collaborative resource-sharing ecosystem on a mission to reform education for the next generation. To this end, GFTA will connect education innovators, philanthropies, and other organizations eager to test and scale initiatives to close the global talent gap.

EdHeroes and Pijar Foundation recently met education innovators across Indonesia, including Princess Mangkubumi, the Royal family of Yogyakarta member, well-known as a youth movement and education activist. They are also a part of the 2022 Asian Venture Philanthropy Network (AVPN) conference in Bali, Asia's largest social investing convening seeking to drive capital toward impact.

EdHeroes Indonesia Hub RoadShow 2022

Creating events in different cities in Indonesia to gather and unite local communities and catalyze educational projects. The goal is to inspire and realize those projects independently and autonomously.

Roadshow events:

- ◆ Bandung (West Java): 10 November, with 10+ community partners, incl. The Local Enabler, Jabar Future Leader, ID Next Leader. Theme: Education Heroes (leveraging momentum of Indonesia's National Heroes Day)
- ◆ Solo (Central Java) — With Royal Palace of Mangkunegaran: 12 November. Theme: talent and culture
- ◆ With Solo Technopark: Theme: Digital/cybersecurity talent. President Joko Widodo visited this technopark in March 2022.
- ◆ "Young Townhall" event in Jakarta, 17 December. Whereby young Indonesian civil servants can showcase their innovation in talent development. This is a highly strategic project due to 3 things: a) endorsement from LAN RI (the government agency responsible for upskilling 4 million Indonesian civil servants), b) partnership with AbdiMuda, a community of young Indonesian civil servants which boasts 59.2k IG followers, c) the three speakers in the event are very influential figures in the Indonesian Ministry of State Secretariat, Ministry of Investment, and Coordinating Ministry of Human Development

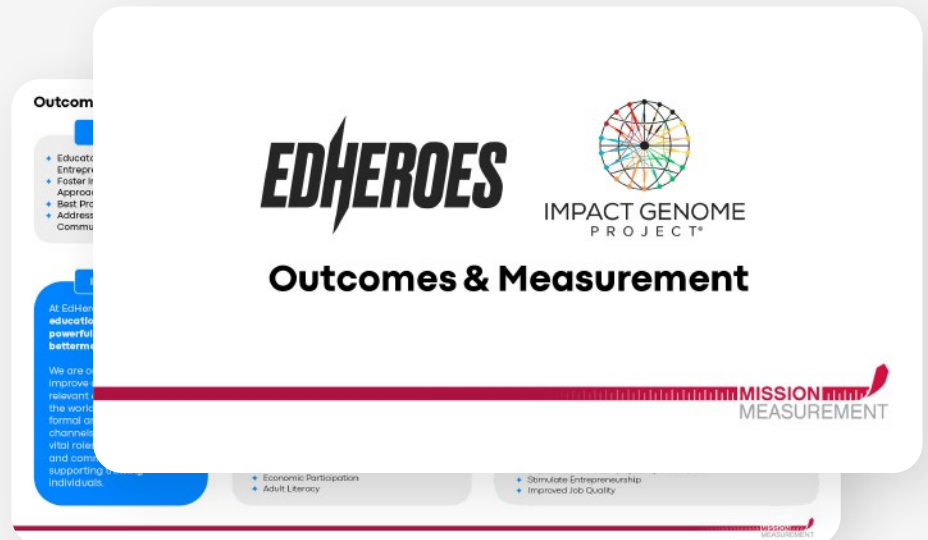
